How to win:

Using the template provided by the Manitowadge Fire Department to create a Home Fire Escape Plan for the students;

- 1) **Primary Residence** - A primary residence refers to a dwelling where a person spends the majority of their time. It may be a house or apartment.
- 2) **Secondary Residence** - A secondary residence is a place where a person spend part time or less than the majority of the calendar year. A secondary residence can include a dual household, grandparents, extended family, or baby sitters.

- 1) May 21, 2019 the Manitowadge Fire Department will be visiting each of the participating schools. A short presentation will be provided on "How to Create a Home Fire Escape Plan"

How to enter:

Using the template provided by the Manitouwadge Fire Department:

- 1) **Eligibility:** All entries must be submitted on the template provided by the Manitouwadge Fire Department. Additional templates can be picked up at the Manitouwadge Municipal Office as stated below. All entries must have parent or guardian consent. Each participant must be a resident of Manitouwadge and registered for the school listed on the envelope.
- 2) Complete all information requested on the template, front and back of page. Make sure all information is legible.
- 3) For your **primary and secondary** residence, create a Home Fire Escape Plan with your homes floor plan drawn. Use arrows indicating two ways out of each room and a meeting place outside of the home. Indicate on your plan with an "SA" where your smoke alarms can be found. For those homes required to have a carbon monoxide alarm mark with a "CO" where they are. Mark with an "X" your meeting spot. (Carbon monoxide alarms are required if your home has a fuel-burning appliance or an attached garage, install a carbon monoxide alarm adjacent to each sleeping area.)
- 4) Practice your Home Fire Escape Plan.
- 5) Have your parent or guardian sign the template and ensure all information provided is correct.
- 6) Drop off the completed Home Fire Escape Plan Template before June 12, 2019 at 2:00, in the sealed envelope provided, labeled with your registered school;
