By-Law 2009-08 Fireworks - Prohibit and Regulate

Did You Know? 2019-03

Manitouwadge has a By-law prohibiting the use and sale of consumer fireworks within the Municipality.

By-law #2009-08

- 2.1 No person shall set off any firecracker within the Township of Manitouwadge;
- 2.2 No person shall set off any fireworks within the Township of Manitouwadge;
- 2.3 A Public Fireworks Display is exempt from Section 2.1 and 2.2 providing a valid permit as outlined in Section 3 has been obtained from the Fire Chief of the Township of Manitouwadge;
- 2.4 No person shall set off any fireworks in, on or onto any building, highway, sidewalk, municipal park or municipal property;
