With a very generous donation from Barrick Gold Inc. the Township of Manitouwadge is partnering with the Manitouwadge Economic Development Corporation to administer the Hemlo Superior Loan Fund to the businesses in Manitouwadge, Marathon and White River. The intent is to assist small storefront businesses in their recovery efforts as a result of closures or loss of income during the Provincial Emergency Order related to COVID-19. Existing and new start-up businesses with gross revenues of under \$250,000 per year can apply for up to \$10,000 to assist them with typical business expenses. 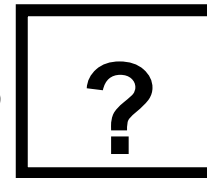

Economic Development Office—Project Updates

The Community Revitalization Advisory Committee is a Committee of Council and was established with a mandate to oversee the Community Revitalization Planning Study and Municipal Rebranding project. Consultants have been hired to assist the Township in completing these projects. Staff and the Community Revitalization Advisory Committee have met with the consultants and have moved the projects forward over the past few months.

Rebranding: The Township has requested the assistance of the Community Revitalization Advisory Committee to develop a new logo and tagline for the Township. Once finalized, the Committee will make a recommendation to Council on the preferred option. If the new logo is approved by Council, the logo will replace the three ~~which is the current logo for the Township.~~

The Manitouwadge Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) is a separate stand alone corporation, not affiliated with the Township. The MEDC owns the rights to the Play in the Extreme brand and is not being rebranded as part of this project.

Community Revitalization Planning Study: The consultants hired to undertake this project will be moving forward with online public consultation over the next few months. More information will be posted about how and where the plans can be reviewed and input received. There will be a mix of online and in person consultations to try to reach as many residents as possible in the redesign of the community entranceway, Manitou Road, downtown core and Prospector Park.

Manitouwadge Trails Master Plan: Through a generous grant from Destination Northern Ontario and partnership with the Manitouwadge Economic Development Corporation and Township, a consultant has recently been hired to map and develop a Master Plan which will help guide the Township on promoting local trails (multi-use and year round) to local residents, neighboring communities and marketing outside the community to encourage new visitors to the community. This increase in year round use of the trails in Manitouwadge will be a benefit to local businesses and create new economic opportunities with an increase of visitors to the community. Public input will be sought both online and in person to capture information from
