



SUGGESTED CANOE ROUTES

*** Philips Creek, (Hillsport Area) ***

- Put in at Puttock Lake Road, off Bound Lake Rd.
- Good pickerel fishing
- Can be accessed through Hwy 11

*** White Lake to Wabikoba/Ravine/Spyder Lakes ***

- Entry and exit point - Marathon Boaters Club
- Previously established route
- Forms a loop
- Canoe Route frequently used by group a group called Outward Bound Experience

*** Granite Hill - Nagagami Lake, Circle Tour ***

- Access through the Foch River
- Need Domtar map
- Go up to Gum Hill River (starts off Shabotik Bay) to Lessard Lake
Reegan Rd. at Moberg takes you right up to Shabotik
- Old native portage to Hook Lake into Granite Hill and circle to Nagagami Lake

*** Moberg Creek ***

- Beautiful trip
- Entry or exit, Lampson Road north or Black River on Highway 17
- Not too many people
- Speckled trout fishing
- Passes beside two old lumber camps

*** Pagwachuan Lake to Pergatory Chutes ***

- Entry point - Pagwachuan Lake, 5 km east of Caramat
- Exit - Highway 11
- Allow extra time for travelling lake (length 12 miles)
- Spectacular chutes
- Not for beginners
- Beautiful, 3 day trip

**** Manitowadge Beach/Dock to Mose Lake ****

- Day Tripper
- Easy paddle
- Nice afternoon trip, approximately 2 hours
- No portages or log jams

**** Manitowadge Lake to Wowun Lake ****

- Day Tripper
- Good fishing, pike, pickerel
- Camp 70 road accessible
- 1 portage from Big Mose Lake to Wowun lake
- 9 km from town by road

**** Beeline Lake to Little Pic ****

- There should be road access within a year
- Good moose viewing
- Japanese Internees camp on Boomerang Lake
- Old prospectors camp at Beeline
- POW camp south of Beeline Lake

**** Gamsby Creek to Slim Jim Lake ****

- Entry point - Slim Jim Lake Rd. - Gamsby Creek
- Exit - Gene Lake Rd (past Slim Jim lake)
- Pictographs at Slim Jim Lake
- Good pickerel fishing
- Easy paddle, no known portages
