Rules and Regulations for Visitors

- Visitors exhibiting signs of illness will not be permitted to enter.
- Visitors who have travelled outside of Canada within the last 14 days, will be asked to leave the property immediately as you must be in self-quarantine for 14 days.
- Visitors must wait at the entrance until directed by staff to enter the building.
- Before entering visitors must use hand sanitizer provided for a minimum of 20 seconds.
- Physical distancing must be observed at all times, with a minimum of two metres between individuals.
- A maximum of two people at one time will be permitted with the exception of a family who resides in the same household in which case that group is permitted, however no other individuals are allowed to enter premises until the group has exited.
- Signage is posted to caution visitors about the risks of COVID-19.
- Visitors are **not** to touch or handle any memorabilia, without exception.
- Washrooms at the museum will be sanitized regularly, only **one** individual allowed in at a time please.
- Visitors are encouraged to leave bags and personal belongings in their vehicle or at home if possible.
- Visitors caught disobeying any safety protocols will be requested to leave the facility immediately and banned to return while safety protocols being utilized.
