Manitouwadge Summer/Fall Market COVID-19 Regulations

- We are counting all customers to ensure we manage appropriate capacity to allow for safe distancing.
- We are requiring all customers to use hand sanitizer upon entering.
- All customers and vendors will be required to wear masks in indoor public spaces as per the Thunder Bay District Health Unit directive.
- The market is laid out in a one-way directional flow. We ask all customers to respect the flow.
- All touch points will be disinfected on a regular basis by vendors at their tables and by staff throughout the arena.
- Public washrooms are available. Only **2** people allowed into each washroom at one time.
- We are asking vendors to adopt a 'no touch' policy. If this is not possible, vendors will be asked to provide personal protective equipment (disposable gloves) to customers and ensure all items are properly sanitized after being touched.
